The business

GigPig was formed in 2022 and is a national startup Software as a Service that works with hundreds of venues and thousands of artists around the UK. The platform helps venue teams find, book, and invoice artists.

GigPig currently has locations in Manchester and Newcastle upon Tyne, with positions including Customer Experience roles, Sales, Technology, Marketing and Leadership.

GigPig continues to rapidly grow, with hundreds of gigs taking place through the GigPig system a week. They are currently looking for more members to add to their development team to further enhance the platform through new features, build in-house tools to assist the wider business, and utilise partner's API integrations.

The role

The candidate will work directly with the senior developer(s) and other development team members to support planning, scoping, building and supporting new feature development. The candidate will be confident in modern javascript frameworks (VueJS, but experience in other frameworks are acceptable), API development (Laravel PHP / REST) and MYSQL.

During their role the candidate will be foremost planning building new features and functions, but occasionally troubleshoot existing issues raised by customers and the internal team (note this is an internal role and will not require customer contact).

The candidate is expected to have a good level of understanding of Object Orientated programming, database structures, MVC design patterns and Unit testing. At least 1 year in an industry role developing within a Laravel framework is required, having utilised features such as resources, actions, queuing, scheduling and providers.

As a mid-level role, the developer will work with senior members of the technology team with an opportunity to contribute to the platform, internal tools and progress to senior roles.

The candidate will be able to work from home, occasionally choosing to work out of the Newcastle office (at least 2-3 times a month).

- Assist senior developers to work with the product owner to take projects from concept, through to production.
- Stay up to date with current web trends and advancements
